Principal Update (William Hack)

- Priorities:
 - Common Core State Standards (CCSC) alignment: in language arts and new this year in math will connect with teacher curriculum mapping
 - Year of the Teacher Leader
 - Integrating Technology into the Classroom
 - Improving School Climate
- Technology Plan
 - Developed from Community Night last year
 - New Technology Teacher (Jason) was hired to help integrate technology into the classroom; funded by PTA
 - Committee to provide accountability with reports throughout the year
 - 40 ipads, 1 macbook pro, 1 apple TV were received from SFUSD
 - Teachers development/training for inputting student assessments
- Korean Immersion Expansion
 - Now content area in Korean, Korean language arts is new
- <u>Wifi</u> new routers in place better connectivity
- <u>California Distinguished School</u> awarded this year (title head for 4 years)
 - Areas CL stood out in were:
 - Bridging the gap of academic success
 - Supporting full-time learning support professional

Budget (Tom Bernard)

- Created over several meetings (involved parents, teachers, administation)
- Budget created in May 2014, now need to ratify during this meeting in case any significant funding change over the summer (none occurred)
- PTA money is held in two accounts PTA account (First RepublicBank) and trust account with district (approx. 1/3 budget goes to the district to be held to pay staffing, etc.)
- Reviewed current budget and answered questions on current items
- Reviewed new requests





- E.g. Challenge Day outside organization comes in and leads team building events, small group discussions – goal to improve school climate
- For any new budget requests, proposals can be made by teacher, administrator, or parent. Policy dictates that the proposal is presented at a PTA meeting, then a vote is taken at a future meeting after allowing sufficient time for discussion with the general membership.

- Tech teacher evaluation: based on SFUSD guidelines; and periodic reporting needs to be done in order to see if future funding will be provided

- 8th year in existence
- Goals: to continue to support outdoor classroom program, 2 full-length Corps members (Emery Donovan K-2 and Greg Nicaise (3-5), supplies for garden maintenance and projects, and sustainability projects
- Madison: New greenhouse; fencing; drainage improvements
- Scott: hand pumps on rainwater harvesting system, fruit bearing plants for trough
- Work days: every month at alternating campuses
