Additional reading support is now available for students at the Scott Campus. This new program is fully funded by the PTA, and staffed by Debbie Magsanay, our Tier II Reading Specialist. Ms. Magsanay is onboard and enthusiastic to assist students and help them succeed in their literary skills.

What is The Scott Campus Reading Support Program?

This program is designed to focus on strategies that move students towards reading independence. It provides daily, structured, fast-paced reading instruction in small groups, delivered at each student's individual level. Our goal is to accelerate students by moving them up to the next reading level, and then having them successfully access grade-level classroom instruction.
