Kamran was selected to represent the United States Futsal at the International Futsal Alliance (IFA) 14 and Under Futsal World Cup. His team competed in Loret de Mar, Spain, from December 6 – 10. They competed against teams from Europe, South America, North & Central America, Africa, Asia, and Oceania. According to Kamran's father, "We won the whole thing!!" They beat Spain for the final and USA is U14 Futsal World Cup Champions!

High School enrollment applications are available for the 2018– 2019 school year. Deadline to submit an application for **SOTA** is December 13 @ 3:00pm (at SOTA) to participate in first round of auditions. The last day to submit an application for **Lowell High School** is December 15. The last day to submit a **SFUSD high school** application (without Lowell or SOTA choices) for participation in Round 1 is January 12th. You may bring your Lowell & SFUSD general high school applications together to Candy at Scott Campus or take directly to the Educational Placement Center at 555 Franklin Street, Room 100. **If you want Candy to submit your Lowell and SFUSD applications, they must be given to her by TOMORROW, Thursday, 12/14 by 9 am.**

Sibling applications are available at both sites. If you have a preschooler that will be turning five years old on or before September 1, 2018, be sure to pick-up or download

an application for Kindergarten. **MOST IMPORTANT: Do NOT turn it in at the Educational Placement Center. Be sure to turn it in to Mrs. Shushtar at the Madison Campus.** Your preschooler's birth certificate, your I.D. along with 2 current bills must accompany your completed application.
