Dear Lilienthal Community,

With just over three months left in the school year we're beginning to plan for the summer and next school year. Our School Site Council and PTA are currently working through the planning and budgeting processes, so be sure to get engaged if that work is of interest to you!

One of the exciting developments that is on the horizon is our new Middle School building which will be located at the Scott Campus. This summer, just days after school closes, the district will be working to remove the portable buildings currently located on the back playground. Over the summer, we will be adding five new portable buildings for interim housing that a few of our classrooms will use and we will be breaking ground on our new building!

The new facility will largely be used for our Middle School. The new facility will include a full science lab, fitness lab, gym, and innovation lab. This ten-classroom building will be located on the North Point side of our campus and the projected opening date will be the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year! This new building is intended to replace the existing portables and will not lead to increased enrollment.

In addition to our new building, the current building will be renovated beginning in the 2019-2020 school year. This project will serve to increase our classroom size, provide more space for our library, and modernize the interior of our classrooms. This update is projected to take two school years as we'll modernize one floor of the building at a time. During the interim, we will continue to use the new portables that will be installed this summer. After the modernization, we will also re-stripe our playground, add a new play structure, and find opportunities for more shade structures and green space (trees and plants not grass) for our students.

As many of you know the construction process can pose challenges. I'm confident that our staff and parents will create the conditions that will foster a fun, caring, and engaging academic environment through this process.

By the end of these two projects (projected to take a total of three years), we will have one of the most beautiful campuses in the district. I'm extremely excited to see

these improvements made. Our children will be able to experience larger, more updated classrooms and will have access to state of the art science, innovation, and fitness labs upon the completion of the construction.

6th Graders! Get Vaccinated!

Assembly Bill 354: The 7th - 12th Grade California Immunization Law : The immunization law requires all students entering into 7th - 12th grades to show proof of a pertussis (whooping cough) booster shot, known as Tdap before the start of school in Fall 2018. **Children who cannot prove vaccination or exemption status will not be allowed school entry.**

Please contact your doctor now to get your child up-to-date on the pertussis booster shot, known as Tdap. Additional immunizations are recommended for your pre-teen and teen. Please talk with your doctor about getting your child up-to-date on meningococcal, varicella (chicken pox), human papillomavirus (HPV), and flu shots. If your child does not have a doctor, please call 311 or 800-300-9950 for assistance with finding a doctor or clinic.

Proof of Tdap for our current 6th graders (who will be moving on to 7th grade) must be given to Ms. Candy for recording in the Student Information System before the end of this school year. Questions? Call Candy @ 749 3516
